There is a spare one in nursery if you need to use it.

As the weather improves please can we remind you that we do not allow 'croc' shoes or 'flip flops' in nursery. They are unsafe for playing in the garden where the children are running, climbing and jumping throughout the day. Please make sure that your child has shoes with an ankle strap.
