### **'Splash day' at nursery!**

Although the weather is very unpredictable at present we are planning to have a nursery splash day on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> August.

All children who come to nursery on this day will need to bring their swimming costumes, swim nappy (if necessary) and a towel to nursery in a named bag. We will be getting out the paddling pools and bubbles for a fun filled day in the sun! (hopefully!).

We will keep an eye on the weather and make a decision nearer the time if it looks as though the splash day may not go ahead.

### **Administration of non-prescription medication.**

We have changed our procedure concerning the administration of non-prescription medication at nursery in accordance with the guidelines issued by Ofsted.

We are able to continue to administer pain relief e.g. calpol, baby Nurofen and allergy relief e.g. piriton in the usual way – by obtaining prior consent from parents. However, over the counter medicines including vitamin drops, cough medicine etc are not now able to be administered at nursery.

We are also able to continue to administer medication prescribed by your GP including antibiotics at nursery following our medication procedure.

### **Extra days at nursery**

If your child comes to nursery for an 'ad hoc' extra day please would you pay for the extra day by cash or cheque on the day itself?

You are very welcome to put a cheque in your child's book bag or give cash to a member of staff who will give you a receipt.

### **Naming your child's clothes**

Please make sure that your child's outer clothes and shoes (coat, hat etc) are named.

There are several children with very similar shoes and similar coats and these are getting muddled up when they are not named. It can be very dangerous if children are wearing shoes that are the incorrect size.

You can mark them with an indelible pen if you do not have the iron-on stickers.

There is a spare one in nursery if you need to use it.
