Sun safety

Now that the summer is here (we hope!) all the children need to have a named bottle of **sunscreen** in nursery and a **named sunhat** in nursery at all times.

Please apply sunscreen to your child before they come to nursery as it takes up to 30 minutes to be effective. We will then apply sunscreen periodically to the children throughout the day.

Summer shoes

All the children need to come to nursery wearing shoes that are safe for outdoor play. With the added challenge of the new climbing equipment the children will be climbing, jumping etc and we must ensure their safety.

All summer shoes must have proper ankle support. **Crocs and flip-flops** are not suitable for nursery and we cannot allow children to come into nursery wearing them.
