The safety of the children is our top priority. **We do not allow children to come into nursery who are wearing 'croc's' or open toed summer sandals.**

This is because the children are very active in the garden especially during the summer months, climbing, running, jumping etc and need to be wearing shoes that fit securely around their feet.
