### **Are you receiving the Friday flyer link? Are you able to access the flyer each week?**

Some parents have told us that they are not receiving the link to the flyer each week, even though they appear to be on the nursery distribution list. If you are not getting the link and need to access the website directly to read it please let us know. We will try to do our best to make sure that the flyer link is available to everyone as it contains useful information about the nursery (eg holiday closures etc) as well as information about the day to day activities of the nursery community.

### **Lost property box**

We have placed a labelled box for lost property in the hallway by the baby coat pegs. Please check there if you have misplaced any items. We will clear the box out each month and lay any odd socks etc to rest!

If you have lost something that does not turn up in the box please let us know and we will do our best to hunt it down for you.

### **Wet weather clothes**

Please send your child into nursery with a raincoat even if it is mild weather as the children play outside in all weathers. We do have our own waterproof trousers which the children wear, but they also need to have named wellies in nursery please as they love to jump in puddles and their shoes are getting very wet!

### **Illness**

Before Christmas lots of children were coming to nursery with very high temperatures and obvious flu like illnesses. Because we are working with very small children, germs spread extremely quickly and can be very problematic for our more vulnerable children. Therefore if your child has had a high temperature in the night and requires 'Calpol' to keep their temperature down please think very carefully before bringing them to nursery the next day. We have a responsibility to all of our children and will not give 'Calpol' as a matter of course, but will instead send them home if we think this is the best treatment for that child. The decision to send any child home is only ever made by Anneli or Sarah. If you have any questions about this matter please speak to Anneli or Sarah who will be able to answer your queries. Thank you.
