All the children will be singing harvest themed songs and baking bread as part of the celebrations.

The children in the Sunshine Room will be visiting the church (At Michaels and All Angels, Blackheath) on Wednesday 12th October in the morning. They will have the opportunity to look at the harvest displays and the vicar will be leading a workshop on harvest for them. If any parents would like to accompany us on this visit they are very welcome.

We will be collecting harvest donations in the days leading up to the visit to the church. These will then be taken to the church and distributed to the London City Mission (based in Waterloo).

If you and your family would like to make a donation please place it on the table in the hallway. The Mission is specific about the range of gifts they need. These are: Tins of baked beans, tins of spaghetti hoops, sugar, brown sauce, tomato ketchup, fruit squash, coffee, toilet paper, toothbrushes, tined fruit, cooking oil, pepper, dried herbs, and biscuits.
