If your child comes to nursery on one or both of these days please would you sign up on the lists outside the rooms to bring an item of party food for the party. Nursery illnesses

Please note that your child must be free of vomiting or diarrhoea for 24 hours before their return to nursery to prevent the spread of infections. Please speak to either Sarah or Anneli if you have any questions or concerns about this.

Change of clothes

All the children in the nursery should have a spare set of clothes (including underwear where appropriate). This is especially important in the winter months. If we do use your child's spare clothes please would you be kind enough to replace them and keep a set hanging on their peg?

If your child is toilet training please would you include several sets of underwear?

Could you also please ensure that your child wears a **warm winter coat**, hat, scarf and gloves as they will still be spending lots of time in the garden and going to the park. **PLEASE LABEL ALL ITEMS OF CLOTHING.**
